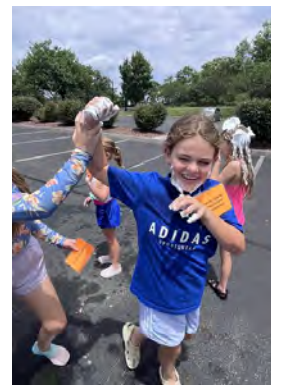
Munsey Week at Camp Bays Mountain was **June 14-19**, and Pastor Chris was the Minister in Residence that week

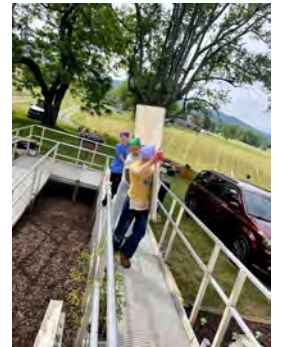
